Pennsylvania Primary Elections are called "Closed Primaries" because you can only vote for the candidates on the Primary Ballot that matches your party affiliation.

#### Last Date to Register to Vote or Change Your Party Affiliation: May 5<sup>th</sup>

You need to register if you will be 18 years old before May 20<sup>th</sup>, moved, changed your name (marriage/divorce) or wish to change your party affiliation.

## Last Date to Apply for a Mail-In Ballot or Vote Early in Person: May13th ALL VOTED MAIL-IN BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 8:00 PM ON MAY 20<sup>th</sup>

### Vote Early and "Bank Your Vote" Before election Day.

- *Mail in Ballot application* – *Each year* you must complete an application and send it to the Election Office if you want to receive a Mail in Ballot. For those that are *"Permanent" mail in voters if* you have not received your application in the mail **yet**, please contact the Election Office.

- *First time voter requesting a Mail in Ballot* – You must complete the application and mail or hand carry it to the Election Office.

- *Those voters having access to a computer*, the application is online at: <u>https://www.adamscountypa.gov</u> (*Choose Election Information*). First time Mail in Ballot voters may want to use this method. Once completed, mail or hand carry it to the Election Office.

- *If you do not have a computer*, you may request an application by calling the Election Office, 717-337-9832.

- You may mail in your Ballot or drop it off. Drop off your completed ballot at the drop box located at the Adams County Courthouse, 117 Baltimore Street, Gettysburg, PA 17325 **OR** hand carry it to the Election office at 230 Greenamyer Lane.
